



## CALL FOR PAPERS & INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

### CALL FOR PAPERS

All the papers must be submitted by no later than May 31, 2008. Please write the papers according to the instructions detailed below and submit them through e-mail to the ECRR Secretary ([info@ecrr.org](mailto:info@ecrr.org)). After the scientific committee review of all the papers, the authors of accepted papers will be notified. All the accepted papers will be published in the Proceedings. One registration fee should be paid for each accepted paper to be published in the Proceedings.

### INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS

The Proceedings of ECRR 2008 Conference will be issued possibly as a printed volume, or as a DVD. In order to achieve a timely publication, Authors are fully responsible for the quality of their articles and are kindly recommended to carefully follow the guidelines described below to ensure homogeneity of the Proceedings format.

#### - General

The camera ready files should be submitted in PDF format (Adobe or compatible, with explicit .pdf extension of the filename) and WORD format (if the PDF format follows perfectly the guidelines, the WORD format is not required). For the WORD format, please use the attached file "ECRR paper.doc" as reference. The paper should be minimum 4 pages and maximum 10 pages in length, including abstract, figures, photographs, tables, references. In any case, the number of pages should be even (4, 6, 8 or 10). The size of the page is directly in the final format of the Proceedings (17 x 24 cm).

#### - Text preparation and submission

The text should be prepared according to the guidelines given below. References, tables, figures, photographs, etc. should be included within the main text. The submitted manuscript should be original and unpublished.

#### - Manuscripts

1. Manuscripts should be written in English. SI-units should be used.
2. The full paper should be organized as follows. The first page should include: A to E requirements, body of the abstract, and keywords. Abstract and key words cannot exceed the first page. Key references can be cited in the text and listed at the end of the text under the heading References. Please do not use more than two levels of Heading.

First page

A - Title, centered, in capital, bold, font size 12

B - Name(s) of Author(s), centered, italic, in font size 12

C - Affiliation(s), centered, in font size 10, with one line space above

D - Corresponding Author (indicated by an asterisk), and e-mail, in font size 10

E - 'Abstract' in font size 10, capital, bold, flushed left, with one line space above, but no space below

F - Body of text of abstract in font size 10, single spaced

G – Key words (text ‘*Key words*’ in italic), in font size 10, with one line space above

From second page

H - Introduction

I - Body of text subdivided in subheadings

J – Conclusions (not strictly necessary)

K - Acknowledgement (if applicable)

L - References

### 3. Page format

17x24, single column, margin left and right 25 mm, top 22 mm, and bottom 25 mm

### 4. Type face

A – Times New Roman

B - Primary heading: 11 points, capitals, bold, flushed left, with one line space above, but no space below

C - Secondary heading: 11 points, bold (no capitals), flushed left, with one line space above, but no space below

E - Regular text: 11 points, justified, with 5 mm indentation at the beginning of a new paragraph

F – Acknowledgements and References: heading 10 points, capitals, bold, flushed left, with one line space above, but no space below. Body of text 10 points, justified. For the references, please follow the role as in the examples shown in the “ECRR paper.doc”

G – References in the text. Please use the following examples as reference:

One Author: (Rinaldi, 2008; Gumiero, 2005)

Two Authors: (Rinaldi & Gumiero, 2007)

Three or more Authors: (Rinaldi et al., 2006)

H – Figure captions: 10 points, centered, below the Figure, with one line space below. Table captions: 10 points, centered, above the Figure, with one line space above. Captions should explain the meaning of all symbols and abbreviations appearing in figures and tables. References to Figures and Tables in the text should be as Fig. and Tab. (for example Fig. 1 and Tab. 1)

5. Letterhead: no letterhead on the first page; Short title of the paper on the odd pages, 1 line, font 10, flushed left; List of Authors on the even pages (surname followed by initial of name), 1 line (if more, use first Author et al.), font 10, flushed right.

6. The organizers reserve the right to reject submitted manuscripts that do not follow the form given in the guidelines.

### - Illustrations, formulae, footnotes

A - Illustrations (line drawings and photographs). Illustrations should be ready for printing and already included in the body of text, centered, in tiff or jpeg format, with resolution not lower than 300 dpi. Colour figures are accepted. Figures should not exceed the width of the printing area of the page (12 cm) (pages in landscape format are not accepted).

B - Mathematical formulae: should be written in electronically compatible form.

C – Footnotes: should be used only if absolutely essential.

### - Copyright

Submission of a paper will be interpreted as a statement that the author has obtained the necessary permission for publication.
