

PUBLIC AND STAKEHOLDER INVOLVEMENT HELPS

- RBM is a multi-manager and multi-user action.
- There are gaps of knowledge, understanding and interest
 - Sitting together and reflecting key issues jointly
 - Meeting once is no involvement
 - Sharing problems and finding joint solutions is unusual in most countries
- Involvement increases confidence in a fair and sound management of resources



PRE-REQUISITES AND TRAPS

- Government willingness.
- Stakeholder interest
- Increasing awareness
 - SH may have extra knowledge
 - Water management is more complex than ever
 - Monitoring evidence of pressure-impact relations
 - Basin approach; polluter pays principle
- Fair share of limited natural resources
- Real costs for the society (accounting)
- No compromise but good solutions.

- Extra work no budget no experience.
- No mutual trust and confidence
- Disclosure of decision-making
 - What happens with valid comments?
 - No external access to data and information
- Local water user & property rights
- Power vs control
- We cannot afford...





ESSENTIALS FOR SUCCESS

- A responsible facilitating team with a clear mandate and budget
- A participation strategy and road map
- An early, inclusive and updated SH analysis
- Regular public information
- Stimulated and facilitated stakeholder contributions
- A public report on the effects of contributions in RBM
- A river basin council with wide representation (rotating?) and rules of procedure
- A compensation for volunteers' expenses
- Regular monitoring of progress in water mgmt.
- Jointly endorsed and published achievements
