## National Consultation in Poland

- March, 20th – during the WWD together with Polish Academy of Sciences and Weather Service – introduction of GWP strategy and basic information on National Consultations;
- Sending out the draft chapters (4 out of 5 subjects);
- April, 11th – together with Polish Ecological Club - discussion about topics (using drafted chapters & presentations);



March, 20th

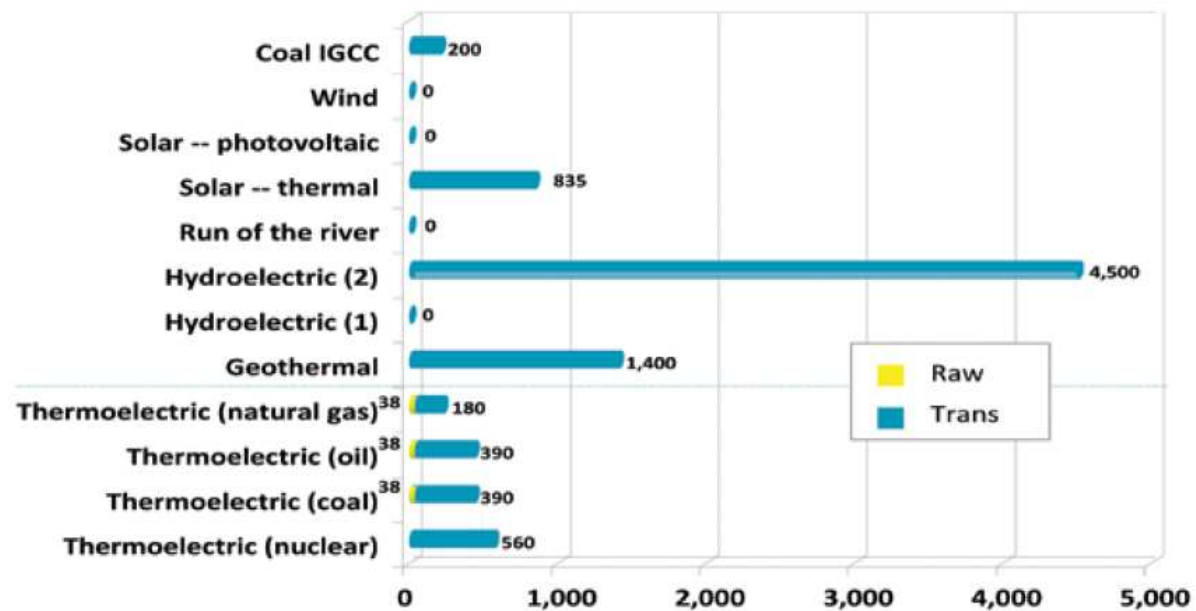
Goals:

- Confirm: GWP as „professionals”
- Stress: GWP as global player
- Introduce: the task and information flow

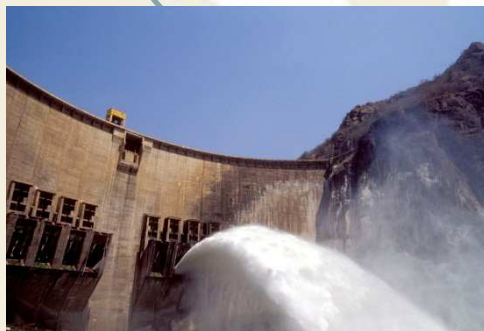
