

RIVER RESTORATION RESTORING HABITATS USED FOR TIMBER FLOATING

In northern Sweden the clearing of streams for timber floating has led to high water velocities, uniform river channels and consequently to reduced biodiversity. Therefore large scale restoration programs are implemented to raise ecological status.



Brown trout and river pearl mussel are focus species, although remediating the entire ecosystem is our main objective
