

We do need to assess stakeholder involvement processes in order to evaluate their effectiveness in terms of ensuring local sustainability along river systems.



















Local people love their local rivers but not everyone will enjoy them (or get involved) in the same way, so local government have to look for creative engagement.





















Engaging people in volunteering in direct actions of river restoration could be a viable and effective way to enhance river conditions.
















